



Waterhouse mill site redevelopment

What is to happen after Kay Metzeler?

Bollington Town Council (BTC) were approached by the owners of the Waterhouse mill site, Rock Asset Management, who recognised that the community would want a say in the future redevelopment of this redundant industrial site.

BTC asked Bollington Civic Society to consult the town's residents and shopkeepers to colate any consensus of ideas for the site and identify the kind of development that would be preferred.

Bollington Civic Society have discussed the possibilities and constraints of the site with Rock Asset Management. We have also been advised by Places Matter! who provide free advice on urban planning and design to communities where major redevelopments are planned.

Bollington Civic Society have distributed a Questionnaire to 3,600 properties throughout the town and 728 have been returned, an externely good response which clearly illustrates the interest and concern in the town for the future of this site.

This Consultation Day brings together the results from the Questionnaire and provides the community with an opportunity to discuss the findings and the options.









9+ acres Low-lying, flood area Viaduct fronted by trees Electricity substation Adlington Road access Mature trees on frontage


















Which of the following options would you like to see put Question 1 forward for planning approval on the Waterhouse site?


A. Retained for industrial/manufacturing use as at present.

C. Mixed use including some employment, shopping, parking, residential and community uses.










Question 2

It is likely that some housing will be necessary to fund the development of the site. Would you be happy with a mixture of housing types occupying a proportion of the site?












Would you like to see the **Medical Centre** expand or relocate Question 3 onto the Waterhouse mill site with facilities for minor treatments and operations, and improved parking?












Would you like to see a medium sized supermarket Question 4 established on the Waterhouse mill site?













Question 5

Numbers of people making suggestions for relocation of shops/ businesses (not covered directly in questions)












Question 6
